## Push to Open

Did you know we keep all of our classroom doors locked for the safety of our students? To enter most classrooms, simply PUSH open the door rather than twist the door knob. In case of emergency a magnet will be removed to allow the door to close and lock. Doors that do not have a magnetic frame have a foam cushion wrapped around the door (toward the top). In case of emergency the foam will be removed to allow the door to close completely and lock.
